In 1938, our credit union was formed as the Cumberland Teachers Federal Credit Union. Our founders saw the need for a not-for-profit cooperative that would provide its members with lower cost financial services, as well as represent their best interests, regardless of their station in life. Eighty years later, we serve over 8,000 members from over 100 select employer groups and continue to grow.

Spring, we can feel it in the air. It's a great time to clear out the clutter, get better organized and reevaluate our finances.

Here are some easy ways to get started.

Review your credit report – You can request a free credit report every 12 months from each of the three major reporting companies (Equifax, Experian and TransUnion). Check for any inaccuracies in the report and contact the credit reporting agencies in writing with any discrepancies.

Assess your budget – Have your expenses or your debt increased since your last budget review? If so, you may need to reallocate your funds and adjust your spending. Paying down debt should be a priority to improve your finances.

Set savings and bills to autopilot – If you aren't direct depositing a portion of pay into savings, now is a good time. If you are, then up the ante and increase the amount. On the flip side, set up automatic bill pay for your regular monthly bills. They will be automatically paid on due dates right from your credit union account, saving you time and eliminating late fees.

Unsubscribe – Are subscriptions and memberships you don't even use eating away at your budget? Netflix, landline, travel magazines or an old gym membership? It's time to cancel them and put the money to better use.

Go green – If you're buried in a mountain of paper, it's time to go paperless. Clean out those dusty file cabinets and shred all of the old documents you no longer need. Opt in to paperless statements on all of your accounts. It will help you to stay better organized.
